HLC Criteria Spotlight

UW is required to provide direct evidence to HLC supporting our case that we meet five criteria. This week's <u>HLC criteria</u> spotlights are on Criterion One and Criterion Two.

Criterion One: Mission

The institution's mission is clear and articulated publicly; it guides the institution's operations.

- UW's mission is broadly understood within the institution and guides our operations.

- Our mission is articulated publicly.

- UW understands the relationship between our mission and the diversity of society.

- Our mission demonstrates commitment to the public good.

Criterion Two: Integrity

The institution acts with integrity; its conduct is ethical and responsible. - UW operates with integrity in financial, academic, personnel, and auxiliary functions; it establishes and follows policies and processes for fair and ethical behavior on the part of its governing board, administration, faculty, and staff. - UW presents itself clearly and completely to our students and to the public with regard to our programs, requirements, faculty and staff, costs to students, control, and accreditation relationships.

- The governing board is sufficiently autonomous to make decisions in the best interest of the institution and to assure its integrity.

- We are committed to freedom of expression and the pursuit of truth in teaching and learning.

- Our policies and procedures call for responsible acquisition, discovery and application of knowledge by our faculty, students and staff.
