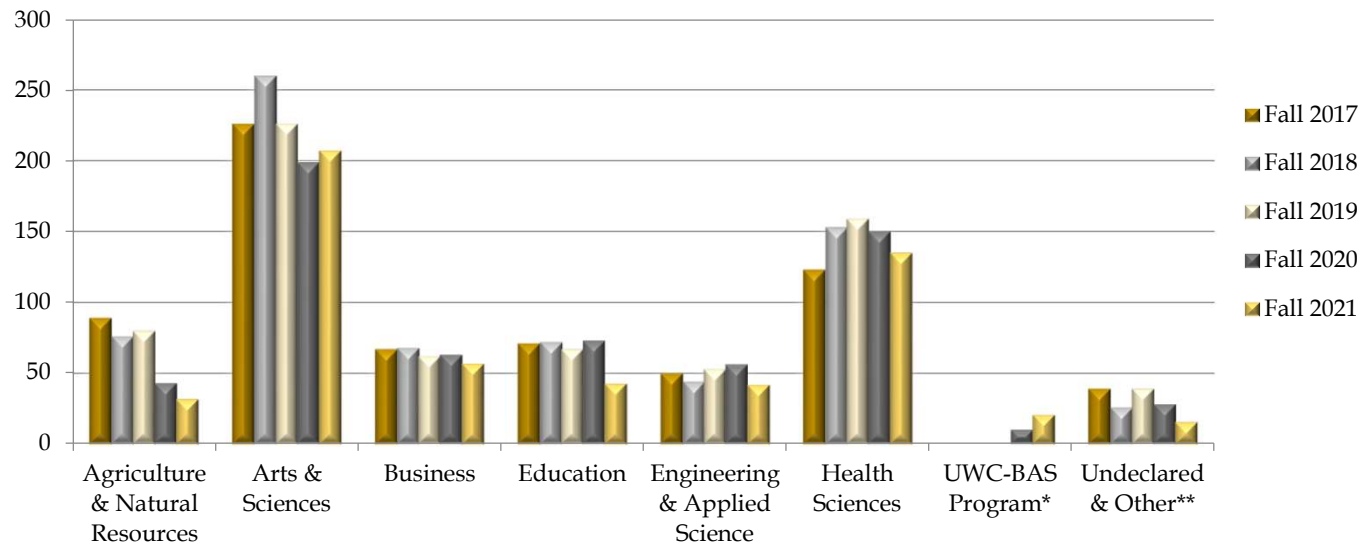
**Figure 1. Headcount of Wyoming Community College Transfers

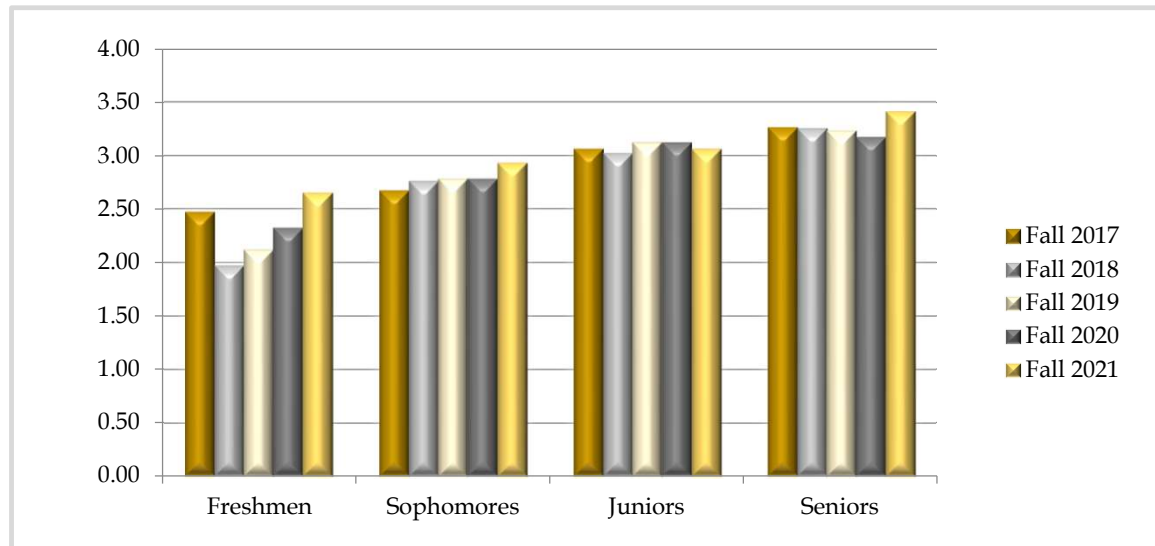

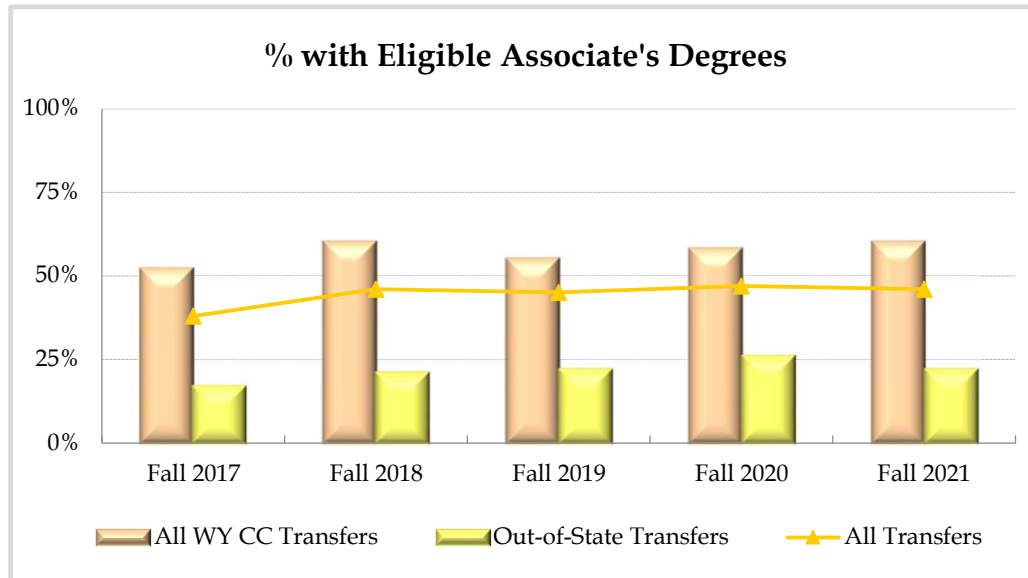
**Figure 5a. Retention & Graduation of Degree-Seeking Transfers from Community Colleges

Fall 2017 - 2021**



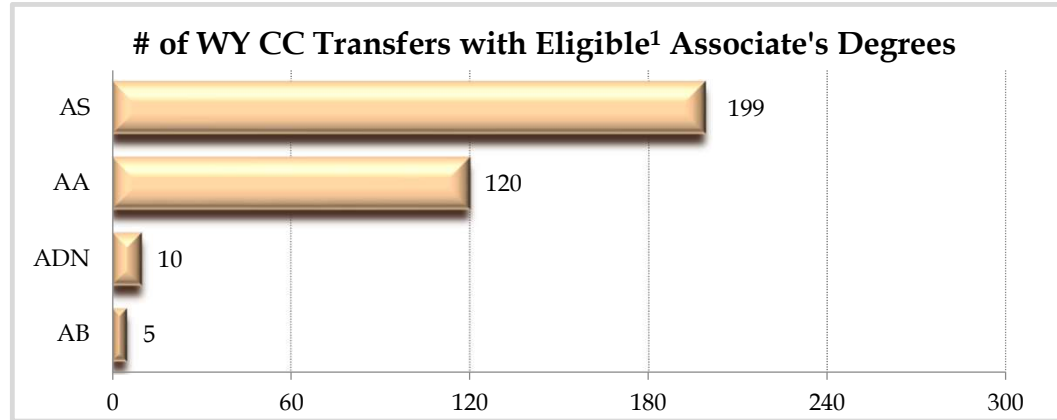

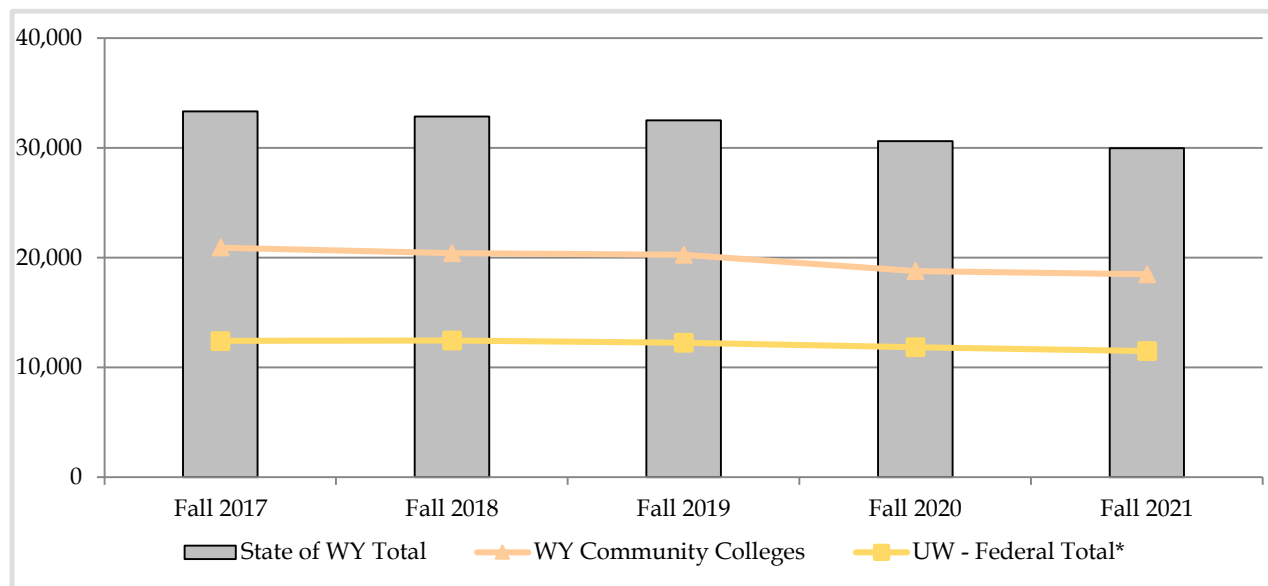
