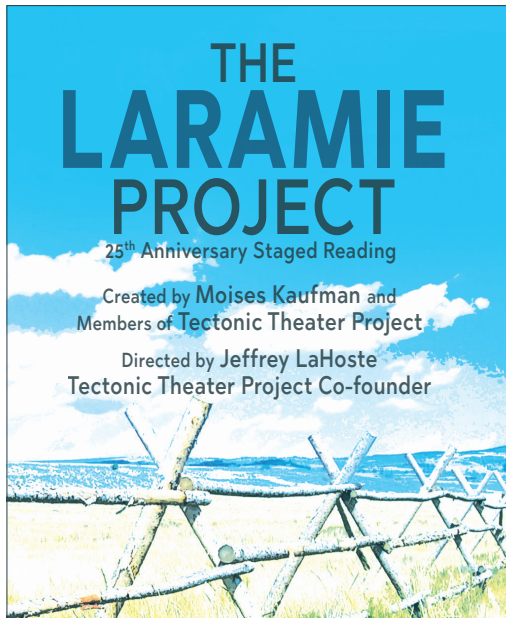

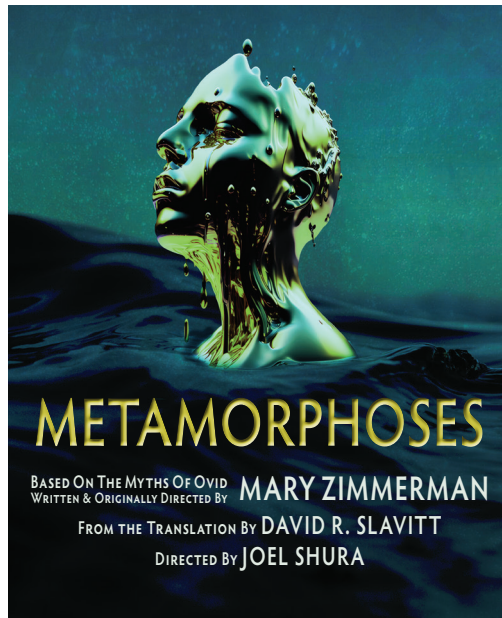

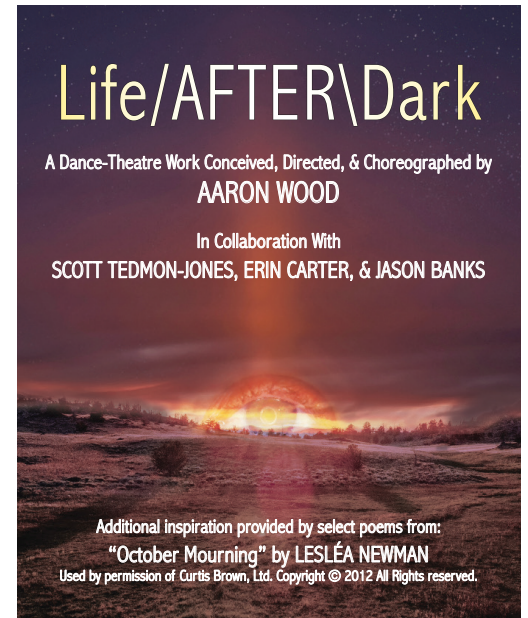
**OCTOBER 11 | 7:30PM**

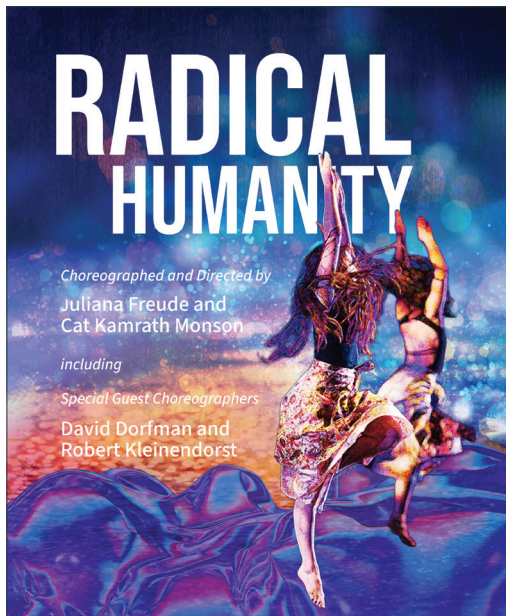

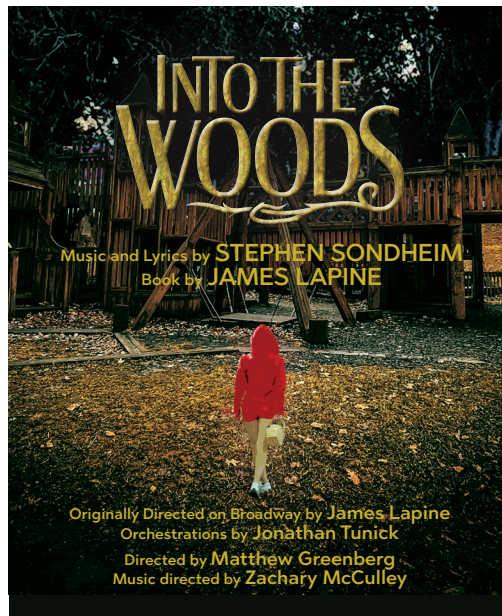
